About the Registry

The Central Saanich Police Service Bike Registry is a voluntary program that allows you to register your bicycle with the Central Saanich Police Service. Registering your bicycle will greatly assist in its recovery if it is lost or stolen and will help us reunite you with it. To register you must be willing to provide personal contact information and particulars on your bicycle. This information will be entered in a police database which will be accessible to any police department in the Province of British Columbia. The personal information you provide will be used for the Bike Registry Program and for law enforcement investigation purposes. The personal information you provide will be retained for a period of 5 years.
